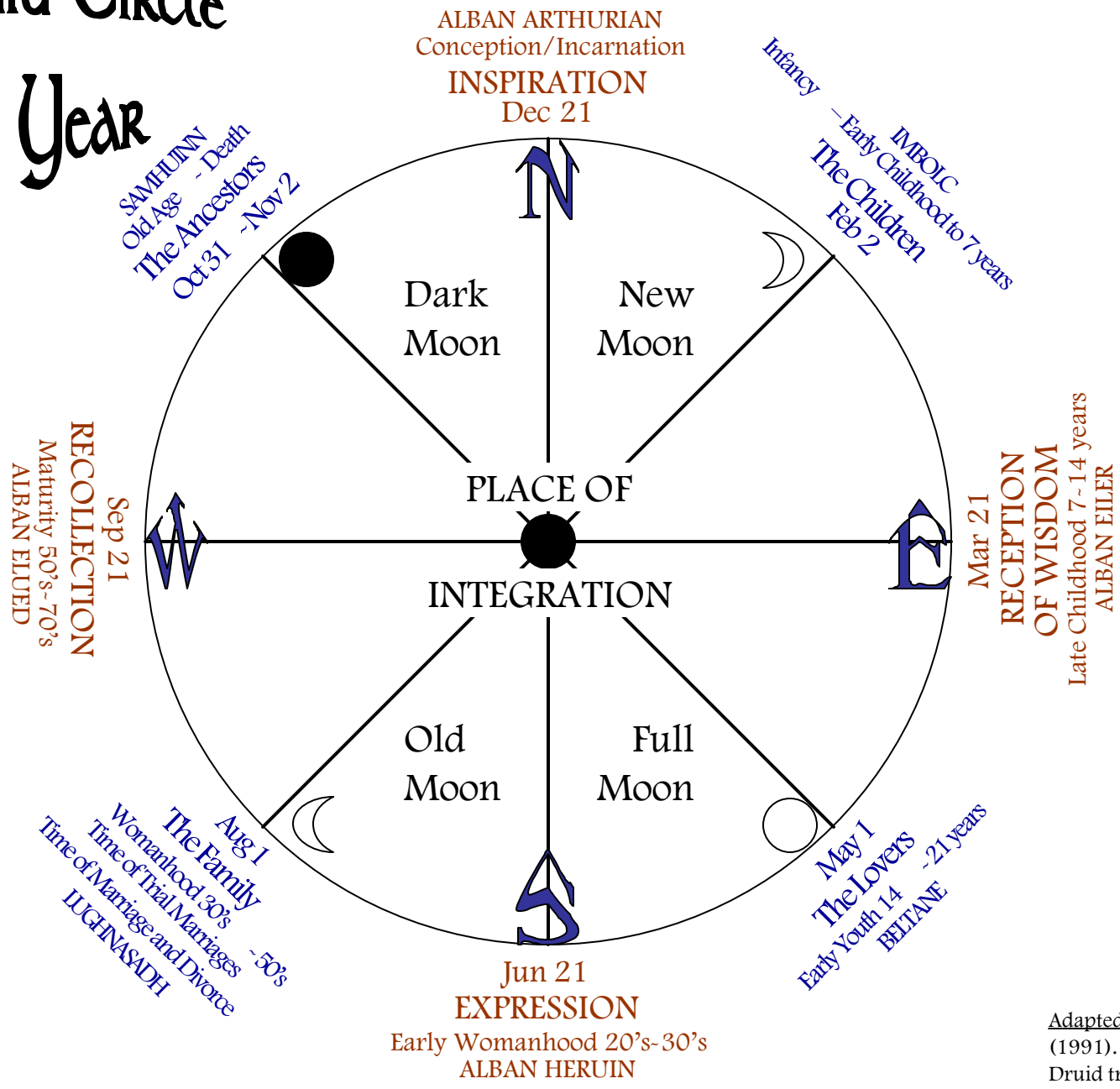

- Battle Goddess
- Chaos/Endings
- Winning arguments, matters of death, rebirth

Lugh

- Master of Arts
- Sun God
- Harvest, artistic endeavors, athletics, sun festivals

Dagda

- Good God/Dozen King
- Keeper of the Cauldron of Bounty
- All-Father/Provider

Bridget

- Goddess of fire, smithing, poetry
- Bringer of light
- Waxing light, matron of bards and smiths/Inspiration

Angus Og

- Young God
- Cupid or Eros
- Matters of love and youth

Boann

- River Goddess (Celtic "Eve")
- Bringer of Rains
- Fertility, love, rain
